### TOURNAMENT RULES, INFORMATION, FORMAT, AND AWARDS

- 1. This tournament will be certified by the USBC and is conducted by Hoosier Classic Charities, Inc, with the assistance of H2M Management.
- 2. A team may have a maximum of eight (8) bowlers with a separate Men's Division and Women's Division.
- 3. All bowlers must hold a valid USBC membership card. All teams must be registered with USBC Collegiate.
- 4. All mixed teams will bowl in the Men's division.
- 5. There will be no smoking in the bowling center at any time per Indianapolis city ordinances.
- 6. Entries will be limited to one team in the Men's Division and one team in the Women's Division per school. Entries will officially close at 8:00 AM for the Men's Division and 3:00 PM for the Women's Division on Saturday, February 16, 2026.
- 7. There will not be a separate NCAA Women's Division.
- 8. Three (3) substitutions may be made during any one game. Once a player has been removed from a game, he or she may not re-enter until the start of the next game.
- 9. The tournament director reserves the right to consult the USBC rule book and may make any rule changes at his sole discretion to ensure fair play.
- 10. The tournament uses a scratch scoring system with separate divisions for men and women.
- 11. For the Men's Division and Women's Division, the tournament will consist of five (5) traditional team games and fifteen (15) Baker games. There will be a total of three (3) lane conditions which will be designed in accordance with USBC Collegiate Rules. ALL PATTERN INFORMATION WILL BE RELEASED ONE (1) HOUR PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED START TIME OF EACH SQUAD. IN ORDER FOR ANY TEAM TO RECEIVE THE INITIAL OIL PATTERN, THE COMPLETED TEAM BALL CARD MUST BE TURNED IN.
- 12. The top eight (8) teams from the Men's Division and Women's Division will be placed into a bracket for the finals. Bracket matches will consist of a best 2 of 3 Baker Games to advance with the exception of the championship match which consists of a best 3 of 5 Baker Games.
- 13. In the event of a tie in Baker Matches, an additional Baker game will be bowled to determine a winner. If there is still a tie, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will be conducted until a winner emerges.
- 14. In order for a team to maintain it's entry into the 2026 Columbia 300 Hoosier Classic, it must field a team of five (5) bowlers for the entire duration of the tournament.
- 15. The final results will be forwarded to USBC Collegiate within ten (10) days of the completion of the event.
- 16. In accordance with USBC Collegiate rules, scholarship money from entry fees may not be awarded.
- 17. Tournament management anticipates a scholarship fund which will be posted on-site prior to the start of the tournament.

- 18. Entry fee is \$300.00 per team for the both the Men's Division and Women's Division. 100% of the entry fee will go towards lineage and expenses.
- 19. First place trophies will be awarded in all divisions.
- 20. All-tournament teams for the Men's Division and Women's Division will be based on the five (5) game scratch total from Saturday. Awards will be presented before the start of practice on Sunday.
- 21. Athletes are allowed to adjust ball surface prior to each specific "block" of the tournament. Once practice begins for each "block", surface adjustments are NOT allowed. For the baker match play finals, each new match will be considered a separate "block".
- 22. Payment deadline for all teams is November 1, 2025. THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON.
